



Paint circles in less than 30 seconds. Circle Taping is not only easy, it's quick!



- 1. Install the needed radius rods to the tape machine and then attach the center pivot.
- 2. Adjust center pivot to the correct diameter and lock in place with attached thumb screw.
- 3. Place masking tape under the front wheels and while pivot is being held in place make the circle.



It only takes a few seconds!

When working on floors such as concrete or synthetic, a co-worker can hold the center pivot in place. When working with a wood gym floor the pivot can be pinned to the floor with a nail and one person can install circles and three point lines.




To produce a straight line, stretch a string or pop a chalk line in the center of the line to be painted. Align the tape machine over the center of the line, pull the tape through the tape guides and place under the front rollers.

As the Court-Line Tape Machine is pushed, the rollers pull the tape through the guides and affix it

firmly to the floor creating professionally straight and accurately spaced lines. The Court-Line Taper will install $\frac{14}{7}$ to 5 $\frac{34}{7}$ wide lines when using the $\frac{34}{7}$ tape guides.

Line guide brackets are marked with both inch and metric scale for easy adjustment to line width. These slotted brackets allow tape guides to be adjusted to varying widths and re very helpful when repainting old lines or installing special width lines. A 1" and 2" wide straight guide is also furnished for the purpose of taping existing lines for repainting.

The **Court-Line Tape Machine** comes supplied with tape guides for $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 1", and 2" wide tape. These are safely stored I the right hand tape collar (marked storage bin) to prevent them from being lost. A 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tape guide is also available but is not included.





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
